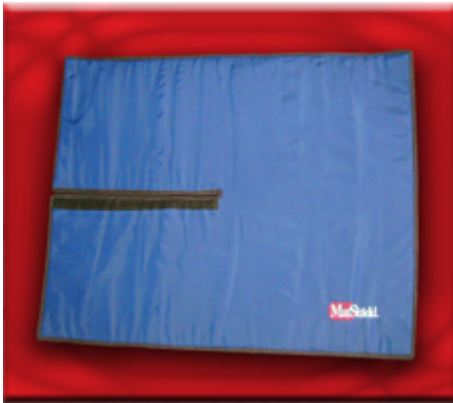




Draping Louisiana medical staff in safety after Hurricane Katrina

No one was prepared for the vast amount of devastation Hurricane Katrina would unleash along the Louisiana gulf coast. Anticipating that thousands of bodies would need to be identified by X-ray due to the magnitude of destruction, an urgent appeal by a Medical Distributor in Louisiana was placed with MarShield. They had a vital need for custom designed lead lined curtains for a Morgue in Louisiana.



A rush order was given to our manufacturing facilities for a special four-panel curtain – each panel measuring 25” wide x 84” long with 1.0mm of lead equivalency, and featuring brass eyelet fittings for suspending. Delivery time would be a critical factor as there was no time to lose.

We slashed our regular manufacturing time in half, once completed, the drapes were immediately dispatched to the site.

Traffic flow to and from Louisiana was bedlam and the client shared fears the shipment would get lost in all the pandemonium. However, our highly trained staff of professionals diligently tracked the consignment and it was safely delivered to our customer on time, for immediate use.
